

Part 1: Model Answer

Do you like to wear perfume?

Perfume? No, not really. To be honest, I don't even really like to use deodorant - I just prefer to shower regularly so that I don't have B.O. I'll sometimes wear deodorant or cologne if I'm going on a date or a night out. But in general, I just prefer my natural smell.

Useful language

Cologne

Lighter smell than perfume (marketed at men).

"I don't tend to wear perfume, but sometimes I'll wear cologne on special occasions."

Deodorant

Used to mask body odour.

"I usually wear **deodorant** more than perfume."

B.O.

An abbreviation for body odour.

"I always wear perfume. I think it's really unattractive when people have bad **B.O.**"

Subtle

Not immediately obvious.

"I prefer perfumes with a **subtle** scent rather than something too strong."

It depends on the occasion

There are specific times when you wear perfume.

"I do enjoy wearing perfume, but **it depends on the occasion**. For instance, I'm more likely to wear it to formal events."

Woody/floral/citrusy

Different scents.

"I like to wear perfumes with a **woody** or **citrusy** fragrance."

Boosts my mood

Makes me feel happy.

"Wearing perfume **boosts my mood** and makes me feel more positive."

Feel more attractive

A boost in self perception.

"I **feel more attractive** when I'm wearing perfume."

Useful language

Overwhelming

Very strong.

"I find some perfumes **overwhelming**, so I prefer not to wear them."

Artificial

Made by humans rather than being natural.

"I'm not a fan of perfumes as they can sometimes smell too artificial."

Allergic

A damaging immune response.

"I don't wear perfume because I'm **allergic** to a lot of the chemicals that they put in them."

Nauseating

Too strong a smell that it makes you feel sick.

"To be honest, I find many perfumes nauseating."
