Live in or travel to many different places over a period of time, meaning frequent changes in residence or location, suggesting a lifestyle or career that involves multiple relocations. *"I've moved around* a lot throughout my life."

Grow up

Become an adult. *"I was born in London, grew up in Edinburgh, and worked in Barcelona, Shanghai and Dublin."*
