*"I plan to stay here for the **foreseeable future**."*

Move around

Live in or travel to many different places over a period of time, meaning frequent changes in residence or location, suggesting a lifestyle or career that involves multiple relocations.

*"I've **moved around** a lot throughout my life."*

Grow up

Become an adult.

*"I was born in London, **grew up** in Edinburgh, and worked in Barcelona, Shanghai and Dublin."*
