*"I don't think I'll move to any new countries in the future- **I'm keen to** settle down in one place."*

Settle down

To start living in a stable and permanent place.

*"I'm keen to **settle down** in one place."*

I haven't had the chance

I haven't had the opportunity or time to do something.

*"I've always wanted to live abroad, but **I haven't had the chance**."*

I hope to + infinitive

Wanting or wishing to do something in the future.

*"In the future, **I hope to** move to Canada."*
