

Part 3: Model Answer - Learning - Question 1

How important is motivation when learning something new?

Very important. Motivated learners are much more likely to stick to whatever it is that they are trying to learn. If they're not motivated, it's going to be very difficult to put in the time and mental energy. Take learning a foreign language as an example. If there's no motivation- either intrinsic or extrinsic- for learning a new language, there's very little chance that someone will be able to dedicate the time and effort required to reach a high-level of fluency- they'll just give up.

Useful vocabulary

Stick to (something)

Keep doing something even if it is hard or boring.

"Motivated learners are much more likely to **stick to** whatever it is that they are trying to learn."

Mental energy

The focus and effort needed to think and learn.

"If they're not motivated, it's going to be very difficult to put in the time and **mental energy**."

Take ___ as an example

Use something specific to illustrate or explain a point.

"Take learning a foreign language as an example."

Intrinsic and extrinsic motivation

Intrinsic motivation comes from inside you (like personal interest), while extrinsic motivation comes from outside you (like rewards or approval).

"If there's no motivation- either **intrinsic** or **extrinsic**- for learning a new language, there's very little chance that someone will be able to dedicate the time and effort required..."

Reach a high-level of fluency

Become very good at using a language smoothly and easily.

"If there's no motivation for learning a new language, there's very little chance that someone will be able to dedicate the time and effort required to **reach a high-level of fluency**."

Give up

Stop trying because it is too hard or frustrating.

"They'll just give up."
