### Vary from person to person

Differ depending on the individual.

*"It will **vary from person to person**, but I'd say the opportunity to learn about a foreign culture is the most exciting."*

### First hand

Directly experienced by yourself.

*"You can learn **first hand** about the customs and traditions of a country..."*

### To see something with your own eyes

To personally witness or observe something.

*"You can learn first hand about the customs of a country and **see it all with your own eyes**."*
