Modern

Using new technology or updated features. "The transport system is very **modern**, with digital screens and contactless payment."

Crowded

Too many people, making it uncomfortable. *"The metro is always crowded during rush hour."*

Poorly maintained

Not well taken care of; often broken or in bad condition. "Some buses are **poorly maintained**, with broken seats and dirty floors."

Unreliable

Not consistent; often late or not functioning properly. "The bus service is quite **unreliable**; sometimes it doesn't show up at all."
