To organise or plan something so that it is ready to use or operate.

"I have to plan the lesson, **set up** the camera and all the equipment, and then after all that, I have to spend a lot of time editing."

My work would be easier if + (past simple)

My work would be easier if...

- I didn't have to commute so far.
- I could work from home.
- my boss didn't give me so many assignments.

Offload

To remove, transfer, or get rid of a burden, load, or responsibility from one place or person to another. "It would be a lot easier if I could **offload** the editing to someone else."
