### Set up (something) / set (something) up

To organise or plan something so that it is ready to use or operate.

*“I have to plan the lesson, **set up** the camera and all the equipment, and then after all that, I have to spend a lot of time editing.”*

### My work would be easier if + (past simple)

**My work would be easier if...**

- *I didn't have to commute so far.*
- *I could work from home.*
- *my boss didn't give me so many assignments.*

### Offload

To remove, transfer, or get rid of a burden, load, or responsibility from one place or person to another.

*“It would be a lot easier if I could **offload** the editing to someone else.”*
