### \_\_\_\_\_ handles most of the cooking

A way of saying who usually cooks the meals.

*"My husband **handles most of the cooking**."*

### We all chip in to do the cooking

A way to emphasise that everyone contributes to the cooking.

*"In my family, **we all chip in to do the cooking**."*

### (To be) fond of cooking

A way of saying that you like cooking.

*"I'm not very **fond of cooking** so my husband does all the cooking."*
