handles most of the cooking

A way of saying who usually cooks the meals. *"My husband handles most of the cooking.*"

We all chip in to do the cooking

A way to emphasise that everyone contributes to the cooking. *"In my family, we all chip in to do the cooking."*

(To be) fond of cooking

A way of saying that you like cooking. *"I'm not very fond of cooking so my husband does all the cooking."*
