Useful for sharing information received from others, like "people have told me" or "I have been told". *"I've never been, but I've heard that it's a very nice place to live."*

Foreseeable future

As far into the future as you can imagine or plan for. "Actually, I love my city and I have no plans to move in the **foreseeable future**."

Climate

The usual weather conditions of a place. It refers to how the weather is typically like in that area. "My family are here, I've got great friends, and I love the **climate**."
